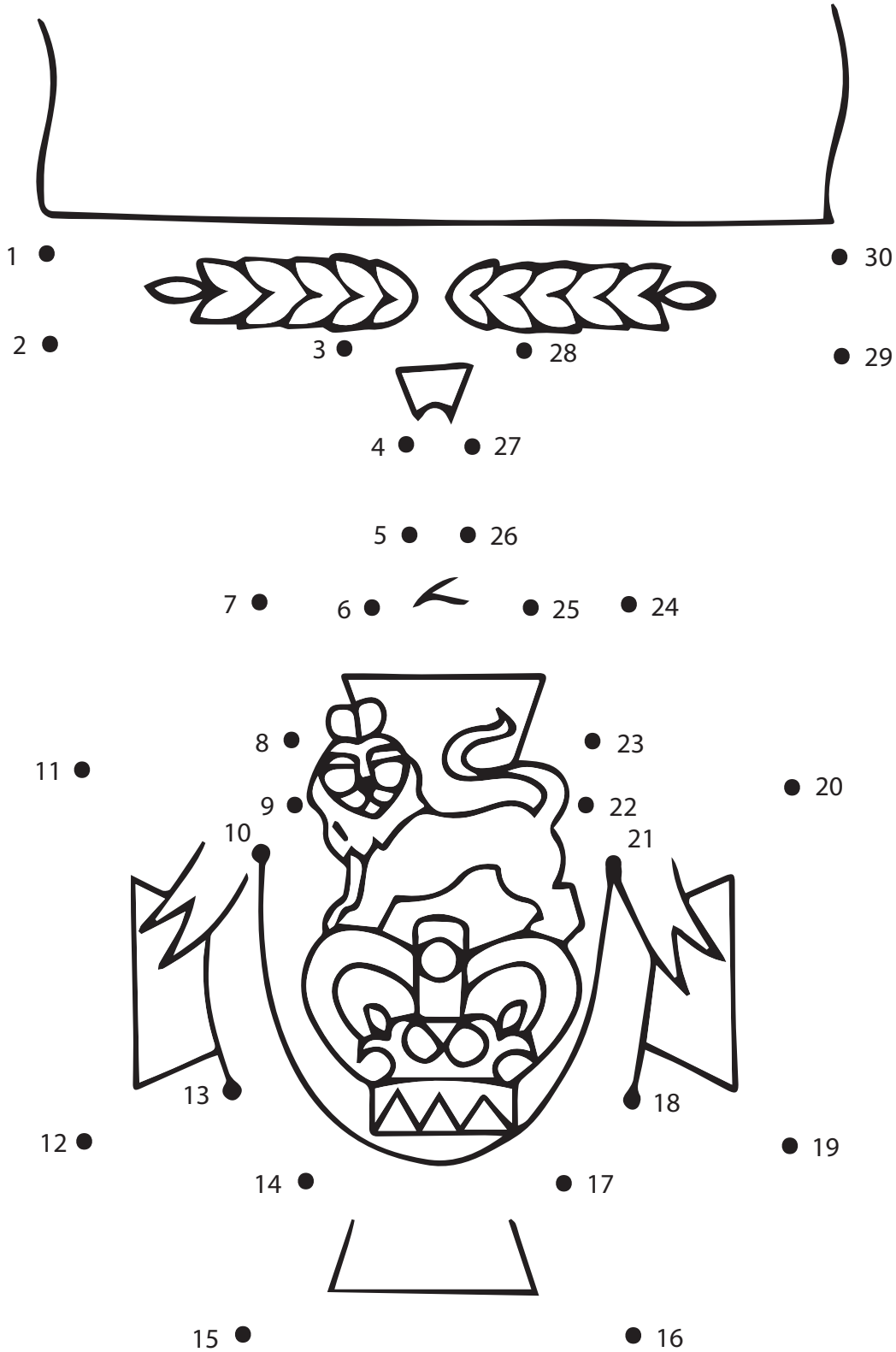

### What?

The Victoria Cross is also known as the V.C. It was the highest award for bravery a person serving with the Commonwealth forces, including Canadians, could receive during the First and the Second World Wars.
