(answer below)

A1 The Dutch.

A2 Sussie's coat was made from a grey army blanket with soldiers' buttons.

Q3 When did Bob Elliot make his decision to join the Canadian Army?
(answer below)

A3 Bob Elliot made the decision to join the Canadian Army at age 15 in 1941.

Q4 When did Bob Elliot return to the Netherlands to visit the Creter family?
(answer below)

A4 Bob Elliot returned to visit the Creter family in 1981.

Q5 Why was Sussie's father Willem Elliot from?
(answer below)

A5 He wanted to resist the occupation and what was happening to the Jews.

Q6 Where was Sussie's father Willem Elliot from?
(answer below)

A6 Bob Elliot was from Olds, Alberta.

Q7 Who invaded Holland in 1940?
(answer below)

A7 Germany invaded Holland in 1940 & stayed until 1945 when Canada helped liberate them.

Q8 Who were the Allies?
(answer below)

A8 The Allied countries included Canada, Britain, the United States and France.

Instructions for folding a cruncher paper

Step One

Print and cut out the paper game.

Step Two

Place paper cruncher with illustrations facing down.

Fold all four corners together so that they meet in the middle of the paper and press firmly.

Step Three

Flip over and again fold all four corners together so that they meet in the centre of the paper and give a good press.

Step Four

Fold in half in one direction, then in half in the other direction.

Finish

Stick your thumbs and first two fingers into the four pockets on the bottom of the cruncher and start crunching.
